まえがき

以下は本誌第1巻 第1号 (1967・XI・1) に収載された表題特殊ビブリオグラフィの追補と訂正・正誤である。すなわち「この種の特定課題についての文献の調査を網羅的になすことは極めて困難である。それに加えて、新しい文献もつねに相ついで現われるので、一朝一夕には成しえられない性質のものではあるが、自他ともに後学のための一里塚の意味をもち、かつこれを一つの手懸りとして大方の叱正と増補とをお願い出来れば、まことに幸甚とする次第である」と、それの「まえがき」においても述べられていたが、その希望と意図にもとづいて、その後約一年間における叱正と増補とをここに行わんとするものである。事実、外部に依頼してえられた叱正は若干に過ぎなかったが、主として内部的増補によって、兎も角もここに 103 の追補と129 の訂正・正誤をいたす次第である。あらためて、先人の業績に一頁を附加しつつ進歩していく、いわゆる科学の歴史性をば痛感するとともに、研究の協同性と累積性の実現具体化を、なお今後にも期待して止まぬものである。

文献は以前には編著者名のA, B, C順に配列して便宜一連番号を附したので,(1)追補に当っては,それぞれの箇所への編入を指示するよう一連番号

に追加番号を附加したものを附した。例えば ~237—2、とあるは、配列順序は237, 237—1, 237—2, そして238となるわけで、仮りにこの部分のみで一連番号を附け替えるとすれば237—1は新238に、237—2は新239に、しかして旧238は新240となるわけである。次に(2)追加番号のない一連番号のもの、すなわち旧一連番号のままで指示されているものが訂正・正誤の分である。例えば旧一連番号のままの374 Leader、Robert E., History of the Company of Cutlers……2 vols. Shefield、1905. とあるは、以前のものにおいて374 Leader、R. E., History of the Company of Cutlers in Hallamshire in the Country of York. 2 vols. 1905. を訂正・正誤せんとしたものである。すなわちこれら両者を比較すれば、その訂正・正誤が何れと何の箇所であるかが判明するわけであり、"……"の部分は再記の煩を避けたものであって、その部分には訂正・正誤すべき箇所がないことを意味しているのである。その他のことについては1巻1号の「まえがき」を参看されんことを希望する。かくて前回の652文献に対して、今回の Addenda は103、Errata は129、Omitted が1であるので、文献総数は754となるわけである。
